To propose that the National Assembly, acting under section 62(1)(b) of the Government of Wales Act 1998:

1. Resolves to delegate the functions of the National Assembly contained in and under the Animal Welfare Act 2006 to the Assembly First Minister.
2. Nothing in this motion will have the effect of reducing the pre-eminence of the authority of the full Assembly or of reducing the role of the Assembly Committees in the exercise of the above functions

This delegation will be made in the knowledge that those functions will, as appropriate, be further delegated to the appropriate Assembly Minister and to staff. There are no functions which by law cannot be so delegated.
