## **Questions to the First Minister**

#### **Balancing Demands**

**Q5 Jocelyn Davies:** How will the Assembly continue to balance the demands of sustainable development, a working rural economy, and health and food safety? (OAQ10418) *Transferred for written answer.* 

**The First Minister:** The safety of food consumers and workers alike remains of fundamental importance and is, of course, entirely compatible with the principles of sustainable development. We are working to ensure that the rural economy of Wales develops sustainably, with high-quality extensive agriculture at its heart.

Questions 6, 7 and 8 were answered in Plenary.

### **Reducing International Debt**

**Q9 Elin Jones:** Will the First Minister make a statement about discussions that he has had with the Secretary of State for Wales regarding support offered by Wales to reducing international debt? (OAQ10415) *Transferred for written answer*.

**The First Minister:** I have regular meetings with the Secretary of State for Wales and we discuss a wide range of issues. He is well aware of the Assembly's support for the efforts of the Government to reduce international debt.

### **Co-ordinating Policies (Partnership with Business)**

**The First Minister:** My colleagues and officials continually aim to foster close working relationships with their counterparts in Whitehall. The concordats that the Cabinet has agreed with Whitehall departments reflect the principles that are necessary to underpin those relationships, including the coordination of policies relating to partnerships with business. I also meet regularly with the Secretary of State for Wales.

**The First Minister:** I have regular discussions with the Secretary of State for Wales on a range of issues, including the Government's legislative programme. As I have said on numerous occasions, all relevant Government Bills should give the Assembly sufficient powers to develop policies that meet the needs of Wales.

As well as meeting Assembly officials, I also met the UK Permanent Representative to the European Union to discuss a range of issues. In addition, I visited the offices of the British Tourist Authority to discuss the promotion of Wales in Belgium. Before returning to Cardiff, I addressed the annual St David's Day reception at the European Parliament, organised by the Wales European Centre.

#### **Foot and Mouth Disease**
