General Dynamics, Oakdale

Yesterday it was announced that General Dynamics, which already operate a 75,000sqft facility employing some 200 staff, was to open a £4m R & D centre on the site at Oakdale. I welcome this new facility being located in the south Wales valleys especially as the company were looking at sites both in the US and the SE of England. As Members are aware, Wales is looking to attract more investment in R & D and this facility will be one of the most advanced of its kind anywhere. This project which will create more than 40 of the best paid and most skilled jobs in Wales, is a great coup for Wales and undoubtably will help in attracting further investment of this kind.

Final Budget
