HEI engagement

HE is not a priority for the Welsh retail sector and its employers. However, we have developed links with the University of Wales Institute Cardiff which offers the country's only retail degree, and with Swansea Institute. HEFCW and Skillsmart Retail maintain an ongoing relationship.

Our SSA research identified something of a skills deficit store management level, and we have carried out further work since then to examine the issue in more detail and to explore ways in which it may be addressed. Although the current demand for Foundations Degrees from retailers is low, the ongoing and future requirement for enhanced store management skills means that this may be potentially an area for development.
