The Committee wholly deprecates the language used at points in the text. We regard it as being both highly personal and capable of misinterpretation as being gratuitously offensive and prejudicial.

The expressions used potentially distract attention from a proper and full consideration of the main proposal in the paper itself.

The Committee resolves that we and our expert adviser should totally disregard the subjective opinion in the paper and focus solely upon the substantive proposal, with appropriate rigour and objectivity."
