(Wales) Regulations 2005 - Points of Clarification and Proposed

**Amendments raised by Members** 

1. The Committee is scrutinising the Regulations in accordance with the protocol for dealing with secondary legislation agreed by the Committee on 11 June 2003 (Paper HSS(2)-01-03(p2c)), whereby members notify in advance any queries they have or amendments they wish to make. Five points of clarification have been raised, and no amendments have been proposed.

## Points of Clarification raised by Plaid Cymru

- 1. From which budget line is the funding for this policy derived?
- 2. What representations or assessments has the Minister made or received regarding a possible increase in prescription costs for repeat prescription patients that have arisen following changes in GP prescribing practice that has led to limiting the amount of medicine prescribed per prescription?
- 3. Can the Minister detail what progress has been made in establishing a definition for 'chronic conditions' and can the Minister detail for what regulations is this definition required?
- 4. Can the Minister detail any limitations on the availability of certain medicines in Wales, but are available in England, that have been established since 2003?
- 5. Can the Minister detail changes in the cost of primary care drugs since 1999?
