Title: Short Policy Review

Standard 2 of the Mental Health National Service Framework - User and

Carer Empowerment

Purpose

1. Members are invited to agree the process for handling the review, the terms of reference and issues for consultation.

Recommendation

2. We recommend that, subject to the views of members on the terms of reference and issues set out below, that the Committee Clerk issues a letter of consultation as soon as possible.

Background

3. The Committee agreed at its meeting on 23 June to undertake a short policy review on Standard 2 of the National Service Framework for Mental Health (HSS(2)-08-04(p7)).

Terms of Reference

- 4. There are five key actions under Standard 2 (see para 6 of HSS(2)-08-04(p7)). These cover a range of issues -
 - Constructive user and carer participation in the development of individual care plans and in the planning, design, delivery, monitoring and evaluation of mental health services;

- The provision of comprehensive, clear, appropriate and helpful information;
- The provision of advocacy services; and
- The provision and assessment and support for carers.
- 5. As the review is to be undertaken over a short period of time it might be best to focus on just one aspect of the key actions. User and carer involvement in planning underpins the other actions and has been highlighted by Mind Cymru and others as a key issue to address. Therefore we suggest the following terms of reference:

To review Key Actions 4 and 7 within Standard 2 of the Mental Health National Service Framework (NSF), as they apply to adults of working age who are covered by the NSF, and also as the principles apply to the elderly and to children and adolescents. In particular to:

i. review the current requirements and guidance for the involvement of users and carers in the development of individual care plans; and

ii. review the current arrangements for user and carer participation in planning, design, delivery, monitoring and evaluation of mental health services.

The Committee will consult with users and carers as well as service providers and commissioners in undertaking this review.

Process

- 6. We recommend the following:
- 6.1 **Public consultation** with key stakeholders, including carers and users and statutory and voluntary agencies. If the consultation letters are issued on 15 July we suggest that the closing date be 20 October, to allow for the holiday period. We suggest that the Consultation letter ask for evidence on the following
 - 1. What does 'full' and 'genuine' participation mean to you/your organisation?
 - 2. What are the barriers to full and genuine user and carer participation in:
 - a) the development of individual care plans; and
 - b) in the planning, design, delivery, monitoring and evaluation of mental health services?
 - 3. How can these barriers be overcome and by whom?

4. What should be the role of:

i. the LHB;
ii. the NHS Trust;
iii. the Primary Care Team.
iv. the voluntary sector;
v. the local authority. and
vi. the service user / carer?

5. Please identify examples of good practice in encouraging full and genuine participation by users and carers in all aspects of mental health services.

A list of those organisations to be consulted is at annex 1.

- 6.3 The review will also be advertised in the specialist press.
- 6.4 Members' Research Service will undertake a **Literature Review** over the summer recess and report to the committee in the Autumn term. The aim of this will be to identify research in this area and examples of good practice.
- 6.5 Members may like to consider whether they should take some of the evidence informally, perhaps in groups of two or three meeting a focus group and then reporting back formally to the Committee as a whole. This would be a more effective way of taking evidence from users and carers.
- 6.6 We recommend that evidence is taken through the autumn term aiming for the final report to be cleared by the Committee at the first meeting in the new year.
