Title: Adult Mental Health Strategy – Update on the Care Programme Approach

#### **Purpose**

1. Paper for the Committee to note setting out progress on implementation of the care programme approach (CPA).

### **Summary**

2. At the Health and Social Services Committee held on 23 June 2004 Committee members requested an update on CPA.

## **Background**

- 3. CPA is the process by which mental health service providers should use to co-ordinate the care for people who have mental health problems. It combines care planning and case management and is an integrated part of the Unified Assessment Process and as such requires an integrated approach from all local agencies.
- 4. The Adult Mental Health Services NSF includes as Key Action 29 that CPA should be fully introduced by the end of December 2004 and this was included as target 3.2 in the Service and Financial Framework (SAFF) for 2004-05.
- 5. 11 Trusts provide mental health services in Wales. The Regional Offices have collected information on progress in implementing CPA and this is set out below.
