Title: The Day Care (Application to Schools) (Wales) Regulations 2005 - Points of Clarification and Proposed Amendments raised by Members

The Committee is scrutinising the Regulations in accordance with the protocol for dealing with secondary legislation agreed by the Committee on 11 June 2003 (Paper HSS(2)-01-03(p2c)), whereby members notify in advance any queries they have or amendments they wish to make. One point of clarification has been raised, and no amendments have been proposed.

Point of Clarification raised by Gwenda Thomas AM

Paragraph 20 of the regulatory appraisal points out that governing bodies of maintained schools have been able to provide childcare facilities since September 2003. Will the Minister confirm that before a school governing body becomes a provider of childcare that all relevant members of the governing body will need to be CRB checked? (Notwithstanding the current situation in regard to CRB checks on school governors.)
