The Community Charges, Council Tax and Non-Domestic Rating (Enforcement)

(Magistrates' Courts) (Wales) Regulations 2001

Background

The Access to Justice Act 1999 provides for:

- (i) the unification and renaming of the Stipendiary Magistrates' Bench to District Judge (Magistrates' Courts)
- (ii) the transfer of administrative functions which were formerly the preserve of justices' clerks to justices' chief executives

In consequence of this the present Regulations make amendments to certain statutory instruments concerning council tax and non-domestic rating, to update to the new terminology references in those instruments to "stipendiary magistrate" and "clerk of the court".
