The Beef Labelling (Enforcement) (Wales) Regulations 2001

Background

These Regulations provide for the enforcement in Wales of a system of identification and registration of bovine animals; and the labelling of beef and beef products and its manner of application in relation to beef derived from animals slaughtered on or after 1st September 2000.

The Regulations also provide for the enforcement of detailed rules in relation to the labelling of beef and beef products derived from animals slaughtered before 1st September 2000.

Having had the opportunity of looking at an early draft of these Regulations, the legal advisers to the Committee were able to identify a number of points which have now been taken into account in the final draft. Accordingly, no points have been identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the National Assembly to pay special attention.
