The Diseases of Animals (Approved Disinfectants) (Amendment) (Wales) Order 2001

Background

This Order amends the Approved Disinfectants Order 1978 by adding some thirty-five additional proprietory disinfectants to the list of approved disinfectants in that Order. The disinfectants which are now added to the list are for use in relation to requirements imposed by foot and mouth disease orders.

This Order has been made under the executive procedure. An Order to the same effect and with the same coming into force time has been made for England.

Although this Order only applies to Wales it is made by the Assembly jointly with the Minister of Agriculture because the transfer of functions to the Assembly preserved the joint action requirement in the Animal Health Act 1981.

The Order has not been made bilingually because the short time for preparation made this impracticable. It is understood, however, that a translation will be published as provided for in SO 23.13. An instrument of this type, being made jointly with a Minister of the Crown, would normally come under Section 3 of SO 23 but does not do so in the present case because orders under the Animal Health Act are not subject to Parliamentary Procedure.

The Order has been published as SI 2000 No. 641(W.31).
