The Undersized Whiting (Revocation) (Wales) Order 2001

Background

This Order revokes the Undersized Whiting Order 1992 which prescribed minimum sizes for the landing and sale in Great Britain, and for carriage on a British fishing boat, of whiting.

These provisions are now contained in the Sea Fishing (Enforcement of Community Conservation Measures) (Wales) Order 2000.

The 1992 Order has already been revoked in relation to Scotland, England and Northern Ireland.

This Order is proposed for the accelerated procedure in Plenary.

Standing Order 11.5

“(Wales)” has been included in the title as set out in the headings but has been omitted from the citation in Article 1. This will need to be corrected either by means of a Memorandum of Corrections or in the printed version. Subject to the necessary arrangements being put in hand, however, no points are identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the National Assembly to pay special attention.

General Observations

Explanatory Note

The statement that the 1992 Order prescribed minimum sizes for landing and sale in Great Britain is correct, as that part of the Order did not have effect in Northern Ireland.
