The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Amendment) (Wales) (No.6) Order 2001

Background

This Order amends the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Order 1983 by replacing the provisions of Part III of that Order which specify the restrictions that apply in infected areas.

A regulatory appraisal has not been prepared for this Order.

It is understood that similar provision has been made for England.

Standing Order 11.5

No points have been identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the National Assembly to pay special attention.

General Observations
