LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Learning and Skills Act 2000 (Commencement No.4) (Wales) Order 2001

Background

This Order brings into force provisions of the Learning and Skills Act 2000. These provisions are commenced on 1 April 2002 with the exception of one provision which is commenced on 1 September 2002. The provisions which are commenced relate to –

National Council for Education and Training for Wales grants to local education authorities in respect of education for those above compulsory school age.

Powers and duties relating to inadequate sixth forms.

Assembly to arrange for assessment of persons for whom a statement of special needs is maintained.

Institutions or employers providing courses for those aged 19 and over only to make payment in respect of approved qualifications.
