**The Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-And-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No.8)
Regulations 2001**

Background

These Regulations implement in Wales the changes to the restrictions on imports and exports in accordance with numerous Commission Decisions that are detailed in the Explanatory Note. In effect these Regulations continue to regulate the export of biungulates, fresh meat, meat products, milk, milk products and other animal products; and contain powers of inspectors, and provisions relating to illegal consignments.
