LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Care Standards Act 2000 (Commencement No. 4) (Wales) Order 2001

Background

This order brings into force on 1 July 2001, section 98 of the Care Standards Act 2000 which amends the Protection of Children Act 1999. The amendments relate to the circumstances in which a local authority may refer an individual who is employed to provide care services to a child funded by direct payments, for inclusion in the list kept by the Secretary of State for the purposes of section 1 of the 1999 Act (list of individuals who are considered unsuitable to work with children). The amendments made to the 1999 Act by section 98 also relate to the circumstances in which an authority must check whether such an individual is included in any of the lists mentioned in section 7(1) of the 1999 Act.

Section 98 was commenced in England on 1 April 2001 (SI 2001/1193).
