The Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-And-Mouth Disease) (Wales) (No.9) Regulations 2001

Background

These Regulations implement in Wales changes in the restrictions on the import and export of animals and animal products, in accordance with Commission Decision 2001/518/EC which amends Commission Decision 2001/356/EC concerning certain protection measures with regard to foot-and-mouth disease in the United Kingdom and repealing Commission Decision 2001/172/EC.

A regulatory appraisal has not been carried out for these Regulations.

These Regulations will apply until midnight on 20th July 2001 and replace the No. 8 regulations which are revoked.

Standing Order 11.5

No points have been identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the National Assembly to pay special attention.

General Observation

As in the case of the previous regulations in this series of Import and Export Restrictions regulations, these Regulations are in English only. It is understood that there was insufficient time to draft these Regulations bilingually.
