LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Agricultural Processing and Marketing Grant (Wales) Regulations 2001

Background

These Regulations provide for the payment of grant towards expenditure incurred in investment for the improvement of the processing and marketing of agricultural products.

A detailed note is to be found in the Explanatory Note.

These Regulations were made on 3rd July 2001 and came into force on 4th July 2001.

Standing Order 11.5

No points have been identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the National Assembly to pay special attention.

It is noted that the following typographical errors which were in the Regulations as submitted to the Committee have now been corrected in the published version.

Regulation 2(1) – “the SPD”

Reference is made to the ‘Schedule’, it is suggested that a capital ‘s’ should be used.

Regulation 2(1) – “commitment”

A small ‘c’ should be used.

Regulation 14

In paragraph (1) 'y pwerau' should be 'Y pwerau'.

In paragraph (5) of the Welsh text the second reference to paragraph '(3)' should be '(4)'.
