**The Import and Export Restrictions (Foot-and-Mouth-Disease) (Wales) (No. 9)  
(Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 2001**

**Background**

These regulations extend the period of operation of the No. 9 Import and Export Restrictions Regulations to 30 November 2001 and make changes to the provisions concerning the dispatch of semen and the export of equidae.

**Standing Order 11.5**

No points have been identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the Assembly to pay special attention under SO 11.5.

**General Observations**

In relation to the amendment to Regulation 14, it is noted that paragraph (3) has not been amended. It is assumed that this is intentional so that whilst the certificate requirement is extended to animals sent to Northern Ireland or the Isle of Man, the requirement for words to be added to the certificate as in paragraph (3) continues to operate only in relation to animals exported to another Member State.
