The Cereal Seeds (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2001

Background

The Cereal Seeds Regulations 1993, made in implementation of EU Directives, contain detailed provision with regard to the marketing of seeds, covering such matters as certification, sampling and packaging.

The Regulations presently under consideration make amendments to the 1993 Regulations in consequence of two further Council Directives.

Amendments to the same effect have been made for England and Scotland.

Standing Order 11.5

Having had the opportunity of looking at an early draft of these Regulations, the legal advisers to the Committee have been able to identify a number of points which have now been taken into account in the final draft. Accordingly, no points are now identified as matters in respect of which the Committee needs to invite the Assembly to pay special attention under SO 11.5.

Some, essentially typographical, points concerning the explanatory note have been drawn to the attention of the drafting lawyer.
