The Plant Health (Amendment) (Wales) (No.2) Order 2001

Background

This Order amends the Plant Health (Great Britain) Order 1993 in implementation of Commission Directives.

Changes are made to the geographical definitions of various protected zones listed in Schedule 8 to the 1993 Order with corresponding amendments to Schedules 1B, 2B, 3B and 4B.

The Order also updates the references to the principal European legislation, reflecting the recent consolidation and repeal of Directive 77/93/EEC.

Corresponding provision for England has been made by the Plant Health (England) (Amendment) Order 2001 (SI 2001 No. 2342) which came into force on 1st August 2001.
