The Artificial Insemination of Cattle (Animal Health) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2002

These amend the main regulations to make transitional provisions relating to the expiry of emergency licences issued under the Artificial Insemination of Cattle (Emergency Licences) (Wales) Regulations 2001 during the outbreak of foot-and-mouth disease, and to enable the Assembly to recognise training courses in addition to those already recognised by the (now defunct) Agricultural Training Board.

Regulation 2(4)(a),(5)(c)(i)

It is not common practice to seek to amend punctuation.

Regulation 2(4)(b)

It is suggested that the inserted paragraph (9B) would have been clearer if the words "to be moved" had been placed after "permit" instead of in their present location.
