LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Revenue Support Grant (Specified Bodies) (Wales) (Amendment) Regulations 2006

Under the Local Government Finance Act 1988 revenue support grant is payable to bodies which provide services for local authorities.

For revenue support grant to be payable to any such body, that body has to be specified in regulations.

These Regulations amend the Revenue Support Grant (Specified Bodies) (Wales) Regulations 2000 ("the 2000 Regulations") by removing two bodies from the list of specified bodies set out in the 2000 Regulations and adding a new body to that list.

Standing Order 11.7

Observations

The use of the English alphabet in the Welsh text of the amendments made by these Regulations is correct as the 2000 Regulations have been drafted using the English alphabet in regulation 3 which lists

the specified bodies.
