LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Food (Emergency Control) (Revocation) (Wales) Regulations 2006

These Regulations, which apply in relation to Wales, provide for the revocation of specified instruments which implemented Commission Decisions imposing conditions on the import of specific products that could be contaminated with excessive levels of aflatoxins. The need to implement those earlier Commission Decisions lapsed with the making of a comprehensive Decision that applies from 1 October 2006.

Standing Order 11.7

In the Schedule to these Regulations, the reference to S.I. 2203/2292 is incorrect. In the title to that instrument "(Wales)" appears before "(Amendment)" and not as shown. [Standing Order 11.7(v)]
