LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Children (Secure Accommodation) (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations 2006

These Regulations amend the Children (Secure Accommodation) Regulations 1991 by revoking regulation 3 of those Regulations so far as it applies in Wales. That regulation provided that accommodation in a children's home was not be used as secure accommodation unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for such use.

Standing Order 11.7

The following points have been identified under Standing Order 11.7

Inappropriate powers have been cited. Section 25(2) of the Children Act 1989 ("the Act") deals with the period that children may be detained, not the place of detention. Section 104(2A) does not contain a power. Paragraph 7(4) of Schedule 5 to the Act deals with offences and does not contain a power. Paragraph 10(2) of Schedule 6 to the Act deals with the review of cases. [Standing Order 11.7(v)]

These are appropriate for correction by a Memorandum of Corrections.
