## 3. Evidence session: Petition P-03-197 Save the Vulcan

The Committee took oral evidence from Cardiff County Council.

## Action

The Committee agreed to:

Ask the Minister for Environment, Sustainability and Housing for the Welsh government's policy position on Article 4 directions in relation to local listing of buildings

Provide the Minister for Heritage with the evidence the Committee has collected in its consideration of this petition, and inform him that the Committee is writing to the Minister for Environment, Sustainability and Housing on Article 4 directions

Ask the Members' Research Service to produce a briefing on the draft Heritage Protection Bill currently being considered in the UK Parliament

Ask the Welsh Local Government Association whether they have made representations to the Welsh government on Article 4 directions and local listing

### 4. New Petitions

## (i) P-03-209 Abolish top-up fees in Wales

The Committee considered this petition for the first time.

### Action

The Committee agreed to:

Ask the Minister for Children, Education, Lifelong Learning and Skills for her position on the abolition of top-up fees
