(i) P-03-255 Special needs education provision in mainstream schools

Petition wording

We at St Julian's Comprehensive School would like the Welsh Assembly Government to consider protecting the provision of special education within mainstream schools in Wales

Background

This petition was raised by Special Education Unit pupils at St Julian's School, Newport, and it collected 14 signatures.

(ii) P-03-262 Academi Heddwch Cymru / Wales Peace Institute

Petition wording

We call upon the National Assembly for Wales to investigate the potential for and practicality of Wales having a Peace Institute concerned with Peace and Human Rights, comparable with those supported by state governments in Flanders, Catalonia and elsewhere in Europe
