- The Foundation Phase covers the period from 3 to 7 years.
- It combines the current Early Years and Key Stage 1.
- The curriculum will be formed under areas of learning rather than subjects.
- It will have a list of experiences and objectives for children's learning.

The proposed changes:

- build on good practice in Wales;
- relate to research on early years; and
- reflect good practice in other countries.

Curriculum changes:

- Personal and Social Development and Well-Being;
- Language, Literacy and Communication Skills;
- Mathematical Development;
- Bilingual and Multi-cultural Understanding;
- Knowledge and Understanding of the World;
- Physical Development; and
- Creative Development.

The Foundation Phase will have:

- a learning continuum from 0-7 that links with the National Curriculum at Key Stage 2; and
- a focus on developing the skills, knowledge and understanding that children will require to be successful in Key Stage 2 and later in their education.

- The consultation ran from 12 February to 30 May 2003.
- Two main strands: questionnaire and seminars.
- >644 written responses were received.
- >4000 people attended the seminars.
- Requests for document from Scandinavia, Singapore and Australia etc

- In the questionnaire there were 19 questions covering each of the five chapters in the document.
- 96% of responses supported the proposal to introduce the Foundation Phase.
- All the proposals were supported and had a clear majority in favour.

- As with any new initiative a few concerns were raised.
- These were mostly related to the interpretation of the proposals.

The Way Forward:

- an action plan prepared;
- a project board set up to have strategic management of the Foundation Phase;
- criteria being developed for the selection of pilot schools and settings; and
- a training audit under way to provide data for a Training Pathway.

- 2003 criteria for pilot schools produced, training and development plan prepared along with a draft of the Framework for Children's Learning;
- 2004 pilot in selected setting for 3-5 year olds and guidance materials developed;
- 2005 Year 1 to join the pilot (possibly Year 2 in mixed age classes)

- 2006 Year 2 to join the pilot, all settings to introduce the Foundation Phase for 3-5 year olds, ratio 1-13;
- 2007 all Year 1 to introduce the Foundation Phase for 5-6 year olds; and
- 2008 all Year 2 settings to introduce the Foundation Phase for 6-7 year olds, ratio 1-8.
