Item 1: Introduction, Apologies and Substitutions

Item 2: Inquiry into carbon reduction in Wales Paper: SC(3)-05-07 (p.1)

- 2.1 The Chair welcomed Gordon James to the meeting and invited him to introduce Friends of the Earth Cymru written submission to the residential section of the Committee's inquiry into carbon reduction in Wales.
- 2.2 The witness agreed to provide the Committee with a web link to information on the actual number of new buildings inspected, together with clarification on the experience of Scotland regarding Combined Heat and Power (CHP) power stations.
