Social Justice and Regeneration Committee – Human Trafficking

Purpose

1. This paper advises the Committee of the Home Office consultation on Human Trafficking.

Background

- 2. A copy of the consultation paper is at Annex 1. Human trafficking is a modern day form of slavery which causes great harm to both individuals who are trafficked and to our society and economy as a whole. Tackling human trafficking is a key priority for the UK Government's organised crime strategy. The Government is committed to drawing up a national action plan aimed at combating and preventing human trafficking, as recommended by international organisations such as the Organisation for Security and Cooperation in Europe (OSCE).
- 3. The consultation is seeking views on the proposed areas for action and specific initiatives which are proposed as well as an opportunity to suggest other areas where a UK strategy should focus. The consultation ends on 5 April.
