Negative Procedure. Date made 5 May 2008. Date laid 6 May 2008". "Coming into force date 29 May 2008. These Regulations amend the Education (Fees and Awards) (Wales) Regulations 2007.

SLC159 - The Products of Animal Origin (Disease Control) (Wales) Regulations 2008

Negative Procedure. Date made 8 May 2008. Date laid 9 May 2008. Coming into force date 3 June 2008. These Regulations transpose in Wales Articles 3 and 4 of Council Directive 2002/99/EC laying down the animal health rules governing the production, processing, distribution and introduction of products of animal origin for human consumption. These Regulations create obligations in respect of animals or poultry from premises where classical swine fever, African swine fever, swine vesicular disease, rinderpest, sheep and goat plague or Newcastle disease is suspected or confirmed, and the infected area and/or protection zone and surveillance zone that is/are put in place on confirmation of one of these diseases. They also create obligations and prohibitions in respect of the meat from these animals and this poultry.
