

LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Town and Country Planning (Miscellaneous Amendments and Modifications relating to Crown Land) (Wales) Order 2006

This Order modifies the Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 by adding a new class of development, secure residential institutions. It also makes other changes to that Order in relation to law courts, and modifies the Town and Country Planning (Permitted Development) Order 1995. It was made using the Executive procedure on 23 May 2006 and came into force on 7 June 2006.
