LEGISLATION COMMITTEE REPORT

The Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Amendment) (Wales) (No.9) Order 2001

Background

This Order makes various amendments to the Foot-and-Mouth Disease Order 1983 (S.I. 1983/1950) covering the following matters –

- number of persons making up a shooting party,
- additional provisions which may be expressly applied by the Minister in an infected area,
- power of inspectors extended in certain specific cases,
- Minister to be able to direct ministerial enforcement of the Order in place of local authority enforcement, in particular cases.

It is understood that similar provisions have been made for England but that they have not as yet been published by HMSO.
