Title: Objective 1,2 and 3 - Updates

Objective 1

The Objective One Programme Monitoring Committee will meet in North Wales on **22 June**. As part of the new format for Programme Monitoring Committee meetings it will incorporate a training session for PMC members.

As previously reported members have been appointed to the Policy Group. The Policy Group has met and will be making recommendations to the PMC on key issues including:

- Spend outside of the Objective 1 area;
- Feasibility Studies;
- Key Funds;
- Responsibility for HRD measures

As at 7 March 2001, a total of **180 projects** have been approved with Structural Funds support of **£137.8 million**. A list of approved projects, not identifying match funding, is available on the WEFO website. The WEFO database update is going well and it is envisaged that for the next PMC meeting there will be available a list of approved projects identifying the match funding.

The recommendations of the Task and Finish Group, which reported to the December meeting of the Programme Monitoring Committee, included the formation of four Strategy Partnerships. Membership of the Strategy Partnerships will be reported to the PMC at the **22 June** meeting. The Strategy Partnerships are expected to meet before the end of March. Significant progress has been achieved in respect of all the Task and Finish group recommendations.

A list of approved projects are listed at Annex A.

Objective 2

The Objective 2 SPD was agreed by the Commission's ERDF Committee on 19 December. It will be formally signed off by Commissioner Barnier later this month without any further

changes. Appointments to the new Programme Monitoring Committee (PMC) have been announced and the first meeting will be held on 26th March .The PMC is constituted on the "three thirds" basis of equal public, private and voluntary sector representation.

Work on the Programme Complement has already started and I expect a full draft to be available at the first meeting of the PMC.

The first meeting of the PMC will also have the opportunity to discuss the proposed arrangements for implementation of the programme developed by the East Wales Partnership, Assembly officials and WEFO

It is currently estimated that the programme will formally start in April once the PMC has had the opportunity to fully discuss the Programme Complement before giving its final approval.

Objective 3

As at 5th March 2001, **92 projects** in Objective 3 have received formal approval for funding of up to a total of £10,663,963.

The Programme Monitoring Committee's next meeting will be held on 11 June in Barry.
