

## **LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND HOUSING COMMITTEE**

### **POLICY REVIEW OF COMMUNITY REGENERATION: EMERGING ISSUES**

#### **Issue**

1. To seek the Committee's views on the issues which are emerging from the work to date on the policy review of community regeneration.

#### **Recommendation**

2. The Committee is invited to consider the issues set out in the annex and to consider the various options identified.

#### **Timing**

3. In the light of the Committee's views, work will be put in hand on preparing an initial list of recommendations for consideration at the next meeting. Once these are finalised a First draft of the Committee's report will be prepared for consideration.

#### **Background**

4. As part of its policy review, the Committee has undertaken a written consultation exercise, has received oral presentations from 14 organisations representing the public, voluntary and private sectors, covering all aspects of community concerns and representing all age groups. The committee has also visited grass route organisations in North, Mid and West Wales.
5. The information gathering part of the review is now complete and certain key issues have emerged from this work. It would be helpful to have the Committee's views on these issues at this stage. These will enable the Secretariat to move on to the next stage of the review and identify key recommendations to be considered at the next committee meeting scheduled for the 22nd May. These draft recommendations will of course be subject to the Committee's deliberations and may be amended and refined as part of the process of preparing the Committee's report.
