Minority Party Debate: Plaid Cymru

NDM1060 - To propose that the National Assembly:

1. Affirms its belief that the benefits of Structural Funds receipts must not be delivered at the cost of existing core budgets financed from the Welsh block.
2. Presses the UK Government to ensure that full "Public Expenditure Cover" and adequate match funding is in place for the second half of the structural funding programme, which follows the expiry of the UK Governments spending plan in 2003.
