**The Procurement Act 2023 (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional and Saving Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations 2024**

I am writing to inform the Committee I have now given my consent to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Cabinet Office to make the Procurement Act 2023 (Commencement No. 3 and Transitional and Saving Provisions) (Amendment) Regulations 2024.

In order to implement the new procurement regime under the Procurement Act 2023 (the Act), Commencement Amendment Regulations need to be laid under section 127 of the Act to amend the date the new regime will have legal effect. UK Government will make these Commencement Amendment Regulations in accordance with section 127(3) of the Act and therefore require the consent of the Welsh Ministers.

These regulations will also bring into force Section 93 of the Act concerning Pipeline notices and will revoke of the current regulations.
