I previously wrote to you to notify the Committee of my intention to give consent to the UK Government for the 2025 Regulations to apply to Wales. The 2025 Regulations intersect with devolved policy and will apply to Wales, England, Scotland and Northern Ireland. The 2025 Regulations are subject to the affirmative procedure and were laid before Parliament on 4 June 2025 and are expected to come into force on 11 August 2025.
