You will be aware that the Children, Young People and Education (CYPE) Committee is currently considering the impact of COVID-19 on children and young people, including students in further and higher education.


Earlier this month, the CYPE Committee agreed a work programme to gather evidence from stakeholders, prioritising the following areas in the first instance:
