I am a teaching assistant working in a primary school used as a hub in North Wales. We have up to 16 children in a day at the moment, mainly vulnerable children. I agree schools need to reopen for children's development and mental health but am worried how it will work. During our usual day during the last 10 weeks there has been very little social distancing, although we started off in work groups these are constantly changing so all staff are mixing and the community hall attached to the school we are using isn't cleaned properly each day. I am worried if it's not being done properly with the small group we have now, then what is it going to be like when we go back properly and who will be checking?
