Dear Llyr,

As we discussed, to ensure transparency on our in year allocations, I intend to publish a second supplementary budget for 2020-21 prior to the October recess. This letter provides further details which will allow the Committee to plan for the appropriate scrutiny.

The main purpose of the second supplementary budget will be to reflect the further changes that have arisen as a result of the measures we have taken to respond to the immediate impacts of the pandemic since the first supplementary budget 2020-21 published in May.

I intend to table the second supplementary budget for 2020-21 on 20th October. The budget will also be published on the Welsh Government internet site the same day.

Given the October recess, I have agreed to move the second supplementary budget motion on 17th November. This provides an additional week for scrutiny beyond the three-week period outlined in Standing Orders.

In line with our standard practice, I will continue to publish a further supplementary budget toward the end of the financial year which will include the full details of the financial package I announced this week to support reconstruction. I will write to you again on this nearer that time.
