**At/To Jocelyn Davies:**

During Plenary on 16 May you requested an update on the funding discussions with Caerphilly County Borough Council in relation to their flood alleviation proposals for Newbridge. I undertook to write to you about the latest position.

As you know the Welsh Government is contributing £31,450 towards the cost of Caerphilly Council's flood feasibility study for Newbridge. Following a review by officials the Council's original report has been amended and the revised report was received from the Council in March this year and is under consideration.

Further grant awards for this project are subject to the outcome of the consideration of the revised report, but I am pleased to say that following an end of year review of our Flood and Coastal Risk Management Grant scheme programme we have been able to provisionally allocate grant from our 2012/13 budget for the design cost of the Council's proposed scheme.

I hope that this information is helpful.
