United Kingdom Internal Market Bill

Following an initial scrutiny session on 21 September 2020, we have arranged to take further evidence from the Counsel General, Jeremy Miles MS, on the UK Government's United Kingdom Internal Market Bill at 10.00am on 2 November 2020.

We have previously worked together on matters related to the UK's exit from the EU. Given the fundamental implications of the Bill on the effective operation of the devolution settlement and for Wales more generally, it may be both pragmatic and beneficial to use this opportunity to undertake further scrutiny of the Bill together.
