The primary purpose of the report is to inform the Assembly's debate on the LCM for the UK Bill, which has yet to be scheduled. However, it may be of interest to you, given that the UK Bill is still making its way through Parliament and will be considered by the House of Lords in the coming weeks.



I would, in particular, like to draw your attention to conclusions 3, 4, 15, 19 and 21, which call on the Welsh Government to seek amendments to the UK Bill in a number of areas. The Committee will receive a response from the Welsh Government in due course.
