Carl Sargeant: We are committed to ensuring that Wales's public transport network is accessible. Our new regional transport services grant will require bus operators to deliver specific outcomes in return for public funding, including accessibility. Approximately 3,000 bus passes have been issued to visually impaired persons under our free bus travel scheme.
