**Children, Young People and Education Committee inquiry into Youth Work: What type of youth service does Wales want? – Follow-up**

In December 2016, the Children, Young People and Education Committee (the Committee) published its Report on the *inquiry into Youth Work: What type of youth service does Wales want?* The Report contained 10 Recommendations, all of which were either accepted or accepted in principle by the Welsh Government. The Welsh Government's response was published on 2 February 2017.

The Committee has been committed to following up on the recommendations made, and has written to the Minister for Welsh Language and Lifelong Learning for an update. The Minister responded on 15 February with a full update on progress made against the Committee's recommendations including her proposals for taking forward this programme of work.


