I wrote to you on 17 July to explain that the National Assembly's Culture, Welsh Language and Communications Committee has been holding an Inquiry into the future of S4C.


I explained that we hoped to publish our Inquiry report in August. I am pleased to tell you that the report will be published tomorrow and I enclose a copy of it for your information.

As I said in my last letter, the Committee is disappointed that it has been so long since the last review of S4C in 2004. The review now planned by your Department needs to start soon and conclude its work urgently. Our report contains a range of recommendations that I hope will be fully considered as part of that review.

I also asked whether you would be prepared to meet me when, or soon after, our report is published so that I can present to you our main findings. I look forward to receiving your reply on this point and I hope you will be able to respond positively.
