Further to the Committee's letter (dated 6 December 2021) and the written statement you issued on 21 December 2021, I am writing to seek further clarity on eligibility for the Winter Cultural Stability Fund. I am sure that many organisations will be grateful for this support during these turbulent times.

Your statement notes that "The Welsh Government is making £5.25m available to assist Wales' arts organisations, museums, libraries and independent cinemas through the winter months." I would be grateful if you could clarify further detail on the eligibility criteria for this fund. Specifically, could you confirm whether grassroots music venues; theatres and similar venues; and freelancers who work in the culture and arts, are eligible to apply to the fund?
