Further to my recent letter advising you of the Finance Interministerial Standing Committee Meeting on 21 March, I write to briefly report on the discussions. A communique was also published following the meeting: Finance: Interministerial Standing Committee – 21 March 2022 - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)

In attendance were myself, Chief Secretary to the Treasury - Simon Clarke MP, Minister for Finance Northern Ireland - Conor Murphy MLA, and Cabinet Secretary for Finance and the Economy Scottish Government - Kate Forbes MSP.

There was a natural focus on the UK Government's proposals for the UK Spring Statement, with little further clarity received at that time. I pressed the Chief Secretary about support for those to be harmed the most by the cost of living crisis, especially for those individuals on welfare benefits. I led an agenda item on Devolved Government budgeting and communications, providing examples of our year-end budgeting experience and stressing the importance of the need for greater certainty. An action was agreed for officials to work together to consider whether year-end processes can be operated more effectively.
